This semester, our ZTC initiative has reached notable milestones:

- More than 20% of all KPU Courses are now designated as ZTC
- We have crossed the \$1 million in student savings in a single semester
- Since we began the ZTC initiative in the Fall 2018 semester, KPU instructors have saved students over \$5 million
